- 1. Open to any member of a Rifle Club affiliated to the N.R.A.
- 2. N.R.A. regulations will govern the meeting except where otherwise stated.
- Any target rifle conforming to N.R.A TR rule 150 or any F class rifle conforming to N.R.A. rule 164 may be used.
- Any commercial ammunition may be used but must conform to CIPP and NRA regulations. 'F' class competitors may use safe hand-loads.
 Hand loaded ammunition is permitted for TR subject to the following
 - conditions: Cal to be .308 Win or 7.62 x 51 mm.
- b. Bullet weight not to exceed 156gr.
- c. HME ammo is not to be used.
- d. ALL ammunition must be safe to use, as described in NRA Rules Appendix VI.
- e. Any concerning activity (blown primers, pulled bullets, etc) will result in the firer being asked to retire from the range.
- Samples of handloaded ammunition may be taken for later measuring and/or testing.
- 5. Sighters are convertible.
- Competitors will commence shooting at the range nominated on their squadding cards.
- 7. Range competitions: N.R.A. rules apply.
- 8. Aggregate competitions: N.R.A. rules apply.
- 9. The Long-Range Competitions will be shot on Electronic Targets and competitors will 'String Shoot". The maximum time allowance for 2 & 10 will be 16 minutes in accordance with ICFR Rule 12.
- Score cards and claim tickets will be available from the City Clubhouse from 07.30 on Saturday upon production of a current Shooters Certification Card.
- 11. N.R.A. classification for the year commencing 1st August 2019 shall apply. (NRA Rule 722). In addition, no competitor will be allowed to compete as a tyro if they have previously won any prize in any open meeting.
- The committee reserves the right to amend the rules and vary the prize list according to entries received. In the event of any dispute the decision of the committee shall be final.
- All entries shall be deemed as acceptable unless the entrant is advised to the contrary in writing or by email. No receipts or confirmations will be issued.
- Entry fees must accompany the completed entry forms and should reach the Meeting Secretary <u>by 30th August</u>. Late entries will only be accepted if target space is available.
- 15. By paying your entry fees you are giving consent to the Meeting Secretary to retain and use information provided in relation to the City RC. Your information will never be sold to any 3rd party, nor otherwise provided to a 3rd party other than under the criteria of any Home Office request in relation to the administration of the City RC. Results will be retained indefinitely for the purposes of future reference and maintaining historical records, and as such they may be distributed to interested parties.
- 16. Competitors who withdraw their entries after the closing date or who fail to shoot on the day will not receive a full refund of their entry fee.
- 17. All prize list protests must be made within one hour of results being posted..
